GENERAL INFORMATION

The Robins are an official co-ed varsity athletic program that are a member of the Minnesota State High School League. Our team covers students in grades 7-12 from Robbinsdale, Hopkins and Mound-Westonka School Districts. All of our games are held indoors in a gymnasium, and our league currently consists of 13 teams from all over the state of Minnesota.

Adapted Soccer (Fall) • Adapted Floor Hockey (Winter) • Adapted Softball (Spring)



JOIN THE ROBINS!

The Robins have two teams with rules designed for each division to meet the needs of students with the various disabilities. The C.I. Division team is for students that have cognitive impairments. The P.I. Division team is for students who have physical or functional health impairments. If a student's disability qualifies him/her for both divisions the parents should discuss with our coaching staff which team would best suit the student's needs. Students interested in our program are encouraged to come visit a practice or game.

C.I. DIVISION - ROBINS "BLUE TEAM"

For a student to be eligible to participate in the C.I. Division, their Intelligence Quotient must be 70 or below (measured using instruments with a reliability coefficient of .90 or greater) on an intelligence test that is standardized, nationally-normed, technically adequate, and individually administered.

P.I. DIVISION - ROBINS "GOLD TEAM"

For a student to be eligible to participate in the P.I. Division, they must have a medically diagnosed physical impairment defined as neuromuscular, postural/skeletal, traumatic, growth, or neurologically impaired which impacts the student's physical functioning, modifies gait patterns, or creates the need or the use of mobility devices. Students who have a health condition such as: a medically diagnosed cardio/respiratory impairment, which significantly limits the intensity and duration of physical exertion as substantiated through physical examination (exam criteria is available) may also be eligible to participate.

TEAM BENEFITS

Adapted Athletics are a great opportunity for students with disabilities to participate on a competitive sports team and earn their varsity letter from their high school for competing in all three sports in one year. This program allows students to learn and play team sports while competing against other teams from around the state.

There are numerous benefits for students who participate in adapted athletics, such as:
